

Aftercare: Erbium Micropeel Resurfacing Laser

The wounds resulting from the Erbium Micropeel Resurfacing laser can be quite confronting but will usually heal predictably and with good outcomes.

The area treated will appear as a raw surface, this is completely normal.

The wounds are left uncovered and a thin layer of Stratacel is applied. This is available for you to purchase at Brighton Day Surgery before you leave. You will continue to apply at home.

It is usual to expect some raw, oozing skin followed by tightness, crusting and swelling.

Washing and showering with mild soap and water is encouraged. If crusts become thick or dry, wash with a dilute salt solution. No make up, sunscreen or skin care products can be used until fully healed.

Apply a thin layer of Stratacel after washing to prevent the wounds from drying out, cracking, and bleeding.
